Guidelines on good publication practice

The Committee on Publication Ethics (COPE) published 2000 the Guidelines on good publication practice. These guidelines are addressed to authors, editors, editorial board members, readers, owners of journals, and publishers and should provide information on publication ethics and prevent scientific misconduct. The main components of the guidelines are, among others, data analysis, authorship, peer review, plagiarism, dealing with misconduct etc. These guidelines are useful as supplement to the Good Scientific Practice Workshop offered by RIGeL each year but also as an important individual document for scientific publishing process.
