## 2 Research Assistants (Postdoc positions)

The positions are offered for a period of **3 years**, if no former times of qualification must be considered. The starting date is **as soon as possible**. The position is full-time with salary and benefits commensurate with a public service position in the state Hesse, Germany (TV-H E 13, 100 %).

In a multidisciplinary approach, the research group of Prof. Dr. Oliver Hantschel aims to target key oncoproteins with novel intracellular synthetic protein-based therapeutics, termed monobodies. The two open positions are funded by an approved grant of the European Research Council (ERC; subject to release of funds) and will allow the successful candidate to engineer and characterize monobodies to novel cancer targets, progress efforts to deliver monobody proteins into cells and/or develop 'mirror-image' monobodies, composed of D-amino acids, with increased stability and limited immunogenicity *in vivo*. These efforts will enable testing of monobody-based therapeutics *in vivo* and a possible clinical translation.

The position will be filled by a temporary contract that is limited to the period which is necessary to gain further scientific expertise (such as the preparation for a subsequent qualification period). Within the entrusted tasks the opportunity for independent scientific work to obtain further personal qualification is given. The limitation of the contract complies to § 2 Abs. 1 WissZeitVG.

The successful applicant will hold a PhD or MD degree in any field of the life sciences, pharmaceutical sciences, medicine or chemistry. Expertise in one of the following areas is advantageous: protein biochemistry, protein engineering, cell biology, biophysics/structural biology, peptide chemistry/chemical biology. The position further requires the willingness to work in a multidisciplinary team. Good English oral and writing skills are required.
